

Car & Trailer (Category BE) Step by Step Guide

Step 1 – Applying for your Provisional Licence

When you passed your car test the DVLA should automatically give you the provisional Cat BE entitlement on your counterpart driving licence, You can check this on the following site: <https://www.gov.uk/view-driving-licence>. If you do not then you will have to apply for the provisional entitlement with a D2 form. You can obtain these from the following website: www.gov.uk/dvlaforms

Step 2 – Driving Assessment & Practical Training Course & Test

We recommend that you complete a practical driving assessment with us. This enables us to assess your driving skills so that we can tailor your practical training to suit you. The assessment will take approximately 1 hour.
