

LGV (Category C) Step by Step Guide - Vehicles over 7.5t

Step 1 – Applying for your Provisional Licence

You will need to undergo a medical to apply for your provisional lorry licence. You will need to order a pack of D2 / D4 forms. You can obtain these from the following website: www.gov.uk/dvlaforms

You will then need to attend a driver's medical. These can be carried out by your own GP, although it is cheaper and often quicker to book through specialist companies, and we would recommend the following:

When you attend the medical, the doctor will complete the D4 form and you will need to complete the D2 Licence Application Form. You then need to send off the D2, the D4 and your photo ID driving licence to the DVLA. You should allow approximately 3 weeks for the return of your licence.

Step 2 - LGV Theory Tests

You will need to complete the Multiple Choice, Hazard Perception and Driver CPC Case Study tests. You can book the tests at www.theorytest.direct.gov.uk or call the DVSA on **0300 200 1122**.

Step 3 – Driving Assessment & Practical Training Course & Test

You will show this with some practical demonstrations and answering questions. We will make sure you are fully prepared for the test, which lasts approximately 30 minutes.
